Subject: Amendment - Label Update/Efficacy Data Review Flea and Tick Powder for Dog and Cats EPA Registration No. 50534-100 Your Letter Dated February 6, 1986

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

- Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- 2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Under the Environmental Hazards section add the sentence, "Do not apply directly to water."
 - b. Add to the Storage and Disposal sections, Disposal statement, the sentence, "Do not reuse empty container."
 - c. Delete the sentence, "Atropine is antidotal." In its place add the wording, "If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine."
- 3. Your efficacy test studies submitted to support the 16-day flea and 7-day tick claims are acceptable. For future reference, this efficacy study has been assigned EPA Accession No. 261603.


