The Brow Band for Haltered Horses is uniquely designed for the long, slim insecticidal strips which will give optimum coverage to areas of the horse where flies are likely to be most annoying. As the impregnated strip swings and brushes the hair coat, the effective, long lasting insecticide is released to do its work.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Classification

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For control of face flies and horn flies, and as an aid in the control of house flies and stable flies, the Brow Band with insecticidal strips should be placed on your horse when pests first appear. Strips may remain effective up to 4-5 months, often giving full season control. The Brow Band may be fastened to your horse's halter simply and quickly. Unbuckle one side of the horse's halter and slip strap into end loops of the Brow Band. Rebuckle and place the Brow Band in front of ears across horse's forehead with the insecticidal strips hanging downward. When attached according to directions, it will allow the strips to swing freely as the horse moves, brushing the coat as it swings.
