Place female tag under clip by depressing lever. Collar on tag must be pointing down.

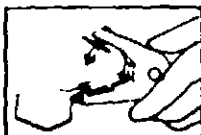


Figure 2.  
Slide male button on pin until it projects through top. Tag and button are now ready for application. Disinfect pliers and tags prior to application.

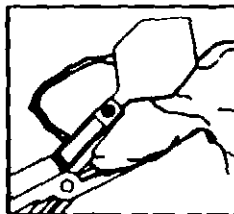


Figure 3.  
Position tag on the flat surface in center of ear. Do not allow shaft of the male button to penetrate any cartilage rib or blood vessel. Ear damage may result.

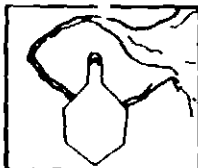
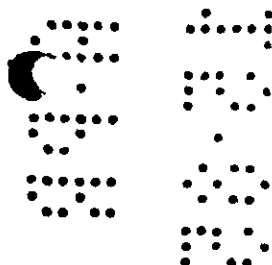


Figure 4.  
When properly positioned, the tag should hang as shown.

### Use Directions:

For optimum pest control, attach one tag to each ear when horn flies first appear. Tags may remain effective for up to 5-6 months for control of susceptible horn flies. Replace as necessary. Apply with the Amflex Tagging System.
