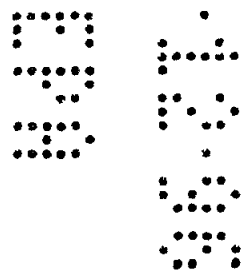

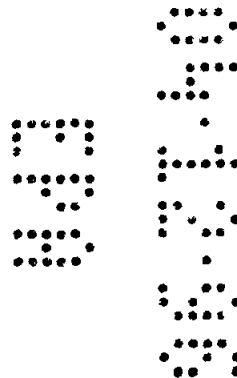

Surfaces to be painted must be clean and dry. Wait 36 hours before painting surfaces which have been cleaned with bleach.

TUFFCIDE 500 may be used in water-based or solvent-based paints and stains by adding **entire contents (1.5 oz.)** of this package to **1 gallon** of paint or stain. After **THOROUGH** mixing, apply paint or stain according to manufacturer's directions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **Open dumping is prohibited.**

Storage: Store in a cool place. Protect from excessive heat. **DO NOT** store product after opening container.
