### Statement of Practical Treatment

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in exterior and interior paints, stains, and coatings.

**TUFFCIDE 500** is a broad-spectrum, highly effective fungicide for controlling fungus, mold and mildew.

Surfaces to be painted must be clean, dry, and free of existing mildew. Follow paint manufacturer's directions for cleaning or for exterior mildew use an EPA registered mold and mildew remover.

**TUFFCIDE 500** may be used in either water-based or solvent-based paints, stains, and coatings.

Add **TUFFCIDE 500** to paints, stains, or coatings using an in-store Additive/Colorant Dispenser as indicated in the rate table below.

**IMPORTANT:** Tuffcide 500 must first be agitated prior to adding it to the Additive/Colorant Dispenser. Follow manufacturer's operating instructions for dispensing the proper dose (see rate table).

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**DO NOT contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.**

**Storage:** Store in a cool place. Protect from excessive heat.

**Pesticide Disposal:** After emptying container, immediately dispose of container as directed below.
