DACONIL 720 is effective for strategic use in programs which attempt to minimize disease resistance to fungicides. Some other fungicides which are at risk from disease resistance exhibit a single-site mode of fungicidal action. DACTONIL 720, with a multi-site mode of action, may be used to delay or prevent the development of resistance to single-site fungicides.
