DACONATE T is a postemergence herbicide for use in residential turf.

DACONATE T contains a surfactant (wetting agent) in proper ratio for best results. It is not necessary to add additional surfactant to the spray tank. Local conditions and recommendations vary for overall use or use of added surfactants; consult local agricultural experiment station or extension service weed specialists for recommendations in your area.

Do not apply to St. Augustinegrass, carpetgrass, centipedegrass or to Dichondra. Mow turfgrass to height of 1 to 1-1/2 inches before treatment. Established bermudagrass and zoysiagrass mix 1 to 2 fluid ounces (2 to 4 tablespoons) of Daconate T in 2-1/2 gallons of water for application to an area of 1,000 square feet. For other turfgrasses, mix 1 fluid ounce (2 tablespoons) of Daconate T in 1 to 2-1/2 gallons of water for application to an area of 1,000 square feet. Application should be uniform and thorough to adequately wet all undesirable plants. Two or more repeat treatments at 14 day intervals may be necessary. Make applications during warm weather when temperature is between 80 and 90°F. DO NOT water turf for at least 24 hours after application. Turfgrasses may be temporarily discolored.
