DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION
For example, to treat 10,000 gallons of water, add 1.0 pound of product. The following table shows the amount of product to add for each 2500 gallons of water. This dosage is based on a water pH of 7.2-7.8 and a temperature of 70-80°F. Adjust dosage if water pH is outside this range and/or temperature is above or below this range. One half pint (8 fluid ounces) of product is equal to 0.125 pounds. Frequency of addition to maintain 0.8 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend upon temperature and number of swimmers. See back panel for the proper chlorination rate in the proper range.

DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF POTABLE WATER FOR HOME WELL WATER SYSTEMS
To disinfect one gallon of water, add one-half ounce of product. Add product to a clean container and mix thoroughly. Add to water and mix thoroughly. Let stand for 30 minutes. If water is cloudy, add another half ounce of product. Let stand for another 30 minutes. Filter water through a clean cloth. Check water frequently for chlorine. Do not drink water until chlorine test is negative. See back panel for further details.

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING FOOD PROCESSING OR DAIRY EQUIPMENT
Clean equipment thoroughly. Just before using, immerse food processing or dairy equipment in a solution containing 200 ppm available chlorine. Maintain this concentration for a minimum of 10 minutes.
