DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hydro-Klear 100 is used to control bacteria and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial air wash systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slimes, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of fluid ounces of Hydro-Klear 100 per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 48 parts per million of Hydro-Klear 100 in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dose of 1.53 to Hydro-Klear 100 per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 120 parts per million of Hydro-Klear 100 employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump. Hydro-Klear 100 is used for air-washing systems that maintain effective mist. To its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 24.7 to Hydro-Klear 100 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each time. Repeat initial dosage until control is effected. Subsequent slug additions of 16.9 to 41.2 fluid ounces of Hydro-Klear 100 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each time. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in the sump or collection trays of the airwash system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
STORAGE: Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking or damaged drums should be disposed of. Spills should be absorbed in sand or other inert material and disposed of in a sanitary landfill, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product should be disposed of in a sanitary landfill, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
