**DIRECTIONS**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use at least two PRO-TREAT 151 PAN TREATMENT tablets for the initial dose to clean out bio-fouling from algae, fungus and slime. To maintain treatment, simply place one PRO-TREAT 151 PAN TREATMENT tablet in the drain pan once a month.
