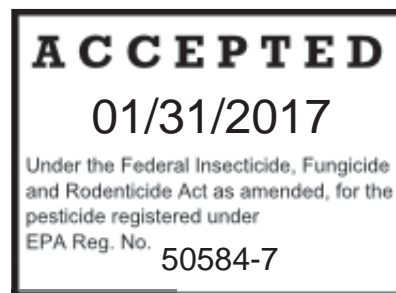

Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals.

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through the skin, or inhaled. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear face shield or goggles, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling. Wear dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval # prefix TC-21C). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, using tobacco, or using the toilet. [These tablets] [PRO-TREAT-151J tablets] are 100% soluble, easy to use and do not form any deposits in the pan or drain line. [These tablets] [PRO-TREAT-151J tablets] eliminate odors and maintenance problems from overflow and water damage caused by fouled pans, plugged traps or drains lines. [They] [PRO-TREAT-151J tablets] are for use in evaporative [humidifier base trays] [humidifier pans] and are not intended for use in humidifier reservoirs.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use at least two PRO-TREAT-151J tablets for the initial dose to clean out bio-fouling from algae, fungus and slime. To maintain treatment, simply place one [PRO-TREAT 151] tablet in the drain pan once a month. For best results, [PRO-TREAT 151] tablets should be placed in the drain pan so that condensate moistens the tablet as it flows down the pan and into the drain line. To keep drain pans algae, fungi, odor and slime free, use at least one [PRO-TREAT 151] tablet for each three tons of system cooling capacity.

HUMIDIFIERS

Every four to six weeks, add one PRO-TREAT-151J tablet to the bottom of the humidifier tray to control algae, fungus, scale and odor. Use [PRO-TREAT 151] [the] tablets to keep pads and humidifiers clean and scale free, increase efficiency, lengthen plate life and protect against rust. To properly treat humidifiers in hard water areas, or with larger reservoirs, two or more [PRO-TREAT 151] tablets may be required. Rinse the reservoir periodically before adding additional [PRO-TREAT 151] tablets. Add new tablet after previous tablet has completely dissolved.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Triple Rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
