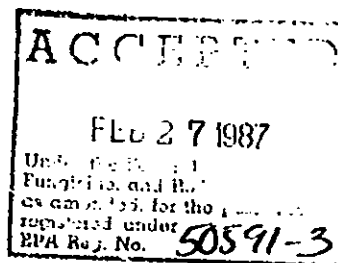

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in
a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING: To prepare dilutions, the
concentrate should first be stirred or agitated well.
Add the required amount of concentrate to water and
blend thoroughly. This will produce a stable micro-
emulsion.

To kill fleas and ticks on dogs and cats and to obtain
protections against reinfestation, follow these steps:

- 1) Dilute at 1 part concentrate to 49 parts water
(2.5 fluid ounces per 1 gallon).
- 2) Wet the animal by dipping or spraying.

To control fleas and brown ticks in the animal's environ-
ment, follow these steps:

- 1) For initial clean up of severe flea infestation,
dilute at a rate of 1 part concentrate in 14 parts
water (8.5 fluid ounces per gallon).
- 2) In normal infestations, dilute 1 part concentrate in
29 parts water (4.3 ounces per gallon).
- 3) Thoroughly spray infested area, pet beds, resting
quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and
behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames
and localized areas of floor and floor covering.
Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters
following treatment.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of
newspaper and discard in trash.
