**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING:** To prepare dilutions the concentrate should first be stirred or agitated well. Add the required amount of concentrate to water and blend thoroughly.

To kill fleas and ticks on dogs and cats and to obtain protection against reinfestation, follow these steps:

- 1) Dilute 4 oz. (118.3 ml) of concentrate per 1 gallon of water. For severe flea infestation dilute 1 oz. (29.6 ml) of concentrate per 1 gallon of water.
- 2) Apply directly to the animals by dipping or spraying. Dip or spray until animal is saturated. Do not rinse.

To control fleas and ticks in the animal's environment, follow these steps:

- 1) Dilute 4 oz. of concentrate per 1 gallon of water.
- 2) Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment.
