

Hand Sanitizing -- In food handling and meat cutting operations: Rinse hands and immerse in a 1 oz. ^{Shepard Bros.} Iodafect Disinfectant per 5 gals. of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).

Retort Cooling Water -- For canning operations -- add 1 oz. ^{Shepard Bros.} Iodafect Disinfectant per 5-10 gallons of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria.

Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization -- 1 oz. ^{Shepard Bros.} Iodafect Disinfectant per 10 gallons of drinking water.

Directions for Use

Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

^{Shepard Bros.} Iodafect Disinfectant is a proven "one-step" cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-deodorizer in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil and 400 ppm hard water.

Disinfection -- Hospitals, Veterinary Clinics, Other Health Care Institutions, Institutions, Industry, Schools, Farm Premises and Poultry Houses:

Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon ^{Shepard Bros.} Iodafect Disinfectant to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, tile, porcelain, sinks and bedframes. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required.

For farms and poultry use, prior to disinfection, all poultry, other animals and their feeds must be removed from the premises. This includes emptying all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Remove all litter and droppings from floors, walls and other surfaces occupied or traversed by poultry or other animals.

After disinfection, ventilate buildings, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry, or other animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried.

Sanitizing -- Meat and food processing equipment and utensils: Remove heavy soils by flushing, scraping, or mopping. Wash with 1 oz. per gallon of ^{Shepard Bros.} Iodafect Disinfectant (or other good cleaner). Rinse with clean water and sanitize surfaces with 1 oz. ^{Shepard Bros.} Iodafect Disinfectant per 5 gallons of water (25 ppm titratable iodine).
