It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DICHLOR-15 is used to control bacteria, algae, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems. Upon its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slimes, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 12 fluid ounces of DICHLOR-15 per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 12 parts per million of DICHLOR-15 in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dose of 1.0 fluid ounces of DICHLOR-15 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in the collection trays of the airwash system.

Subsequent slug additions of 1.0 fluid ounces of DICHLOR-15 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in the collection trays of the airwash system.
