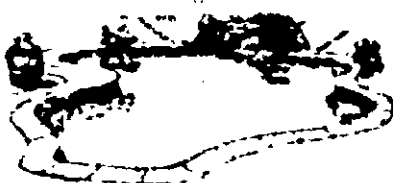

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION

For a new pool or for spring start-up, use chlorinator with 0.4 (1/2 pint) 100 fluid oz. of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 2500 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE

A) Adjust pH of water to 7.2 to 7.6 range and maintain. B) Add 3 mg/l. of sodium hypochlorite solution to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. (one half pint (8 fluid oz.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 6000 gallons of water) will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequent small additions to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on temperature and number of swimmers. Use test kit to make certain the pH and chlorine residual are in the proper range.

NOTE: This product will add with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage as necessary to maintain the required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. Do not store in a confined area with large quantities of water. Dispose of by diluting with water and either pouring into the sewer or by placing in trash collection or burning in an approved incinerator. Do not use for anything other than its intended use.
