This letter is to acknowledge the receipt and review of the acute inhalation study (MRID 419510-02) to support the subject registration. The study is acceptable and classified as Toxicity Category III. A copy of the precautionary review is enclosed for your review.

Based on the toxicity profile of the subject product, the product labeling is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals to read as follows;

Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin or clothing and inhaling ~~or~~ spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuff.

2. The Statement of Practical Treatment should be revised to read as follows:

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air, if not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

- 3. Since the product has outdoor uses add the following Environmental Hazards Statement:

"ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: "This product is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Cover ornamental, fish ponds/pools before treatment."

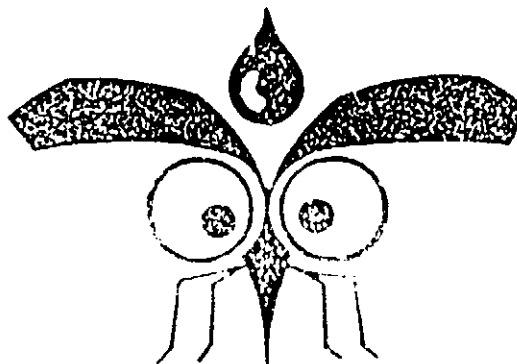

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

Point valve attachment from the pump toward target area. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. NOTE: Do not contaminate food, utensils, dishes or drinking water. Do not use in food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is customarily prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is being served or prepared. Do not use in areas where food is being prepared or served. Do not use in areas where food is being prepared or served.

NON-FOOD, FEED AREAS

garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). In the home cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not spray on furniture.

INDOORS - FOR HOUSE FLIES, MOSQUITOS, AND GNATS

Close all doors and windows. Adjust spray nozzle for fine mist and point upward. Direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially near windows and other light sources which attract these insects. After the room is filled with the mist, leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

INDOORS - FOR CRAWLING INSECTS.

Roaches, fleas, silverfishes, earwings, sowbugs, mites, spiders and centipedes. Adjust spray nozzle for coarse spray droplets. Spray thoroughly toward hiding places, such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, firewood piles, openings around pipes and sink, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

INDOORS - ANTS: Spray trails nest and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

INDOORS - DOG FLEAS: To reduce reinfection of areas infested with dog and cat fleas, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding and other resting areas. Treat these areas at the rate of 2 seconds per linear foot while spraying at a distance of 12 to 18 inches from target. Also spray entire inside service of dog houses. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - TO KILL FLYING INSECTS - Adjust spray nozzle for fine mist. Spray areas infested with mosquitoes, gnats (midges), house flies, biting flies and pyralid and noctuid flying moths. Follow precautions listed above. Hold nozzle 12 to 24 inches from target, human and animal areas. Spray these areas with a sweeping motion at the rate of 10 to 15 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - ANTS. Spray trails, nests and point of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - SPIDERS. Direct short bursts of spray on spiders and repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - WASPS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects possible. Repeat as necessary.

DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse empty pesticide containers other than the application equipment. Wrap the container and put into trash collection.
