- c. The conversion from square meters should be square yards. We suggest you revise that portion of your direction for number of carpets to use as follows:

"Avoid touching the treated carpet surface. Use 1 carpet for approximately 45 square feet of area to treat. For example a 10 feet x 13 feet room use at least 3 carpets. Place units under major appliances and other out of the way places where children and pets will have not contact with it. These units should be placed and left...."

- d. As indicated in our last letter you may delete the statement, "In the home cover all food handling surfaces and cover..."

3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Place units under major appliances and other out of the way places where children and pets will have no contact with it. ~~The unit may also be placed in open areas at night when roaches are active and children and pets are removed from the area. In the morning the unit can be folded up and stored away out of the reach of children.~~

- STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from feed and foodstuffs
- DISPOSAL: Wrap carpet in several layers of paper and discard in trash collection.
