The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable, provided you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling:

- 1. Amend the STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT per PR Notice 2001-1.
- 2. Under PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS, change the word "Hazardous" to "Hazards".
- 3. Under DISPOSAL, add the phrase, "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal".

For use in homes, apartments in multi-residential buildings, kitchens, bathrooms, pantries, closets, garages and other areas where cockroaches / pests are found For commercial and industrial establishments. Use Cockroach Carpet in food shipping and handling establishments and processing plants, including but not limited to federally inspected meat and poultry plants, kitchens, supermarkets, hotels, motels hospitals, nursing homes, office buildings, schools, warehouses, kennels, ships, airplanes, railroad cars, highway vehicles and other areas where cockroaches /pests are found. For use in inaccessible places of food handling and serving areas and food processing plants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in any manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To avoid contact with the active ingredients, remove from wrapper by grasping at the special built-in grip handles. Fully unfold Cockroach Carpet and place with treated side upward in area frequented by cockroaches / pests.

Place under cupboards, refrigerators, stoves, shelves, etc., remove when cleaning. Do not place Cockroach Carpet on surfaces that are used for food preparation. Replace Cockroach Carpet every six months. In open areas use only if area is inaccessible (i.e. under lock and key). Before opening up area remove Cockroach Carpet and store in bag and place in secured location.

Use one (1) unit for approximately 75 square feet of area to be treated

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazardous to Humans and Domestic Animals

Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contaminating of feed and food stuffs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
