DIRECTIONS FOR USE

(Read entire label before making applications)
Foliar Spray for Green House Ornamentals, and Potatoes and Tomatoes:

For use on foliage of flowering plants, potatoes and tomatoes, shrubs or trees, dilute 2 tablespoons in 1 gallon of water and spray until solution drips off leaves. For large areas, spray 1 quart of Sea-Born per acre diluted in 15 or 20 gallons of water at 35 lb. psi. Applications should be repeated three or four times during the growing season.

Row Crops:

Preplant: Apply 1 quart per acre, diluted in 5 to 25 gallons of water.

Foliar Spray: 1st Application: Apply 1/2 gallon per acre diluted in 2-15 gallons of water 30-40 days after emergence.

2nd Application: Apply 1/2 gallon per acre diluted in 2-15 gallons of water 3-4 weeks after 1st application.

3rd Application: Apply 1/2 gallon per acre diluted in 2-15 gallons of water 2-3 weeks prior to fruit setting.

Time of Day and Weather Condition:

The greatest product performance occurs when Sea-Born is applied when air temperature is 85° F. or below and the sun is not directly overhead. Do not apply after heavy dew, on rainy days, or when rain is predicted within 12 hours after application.
