You may retain your warnings on damage to materials.


e. Remove the statement "NOT FOR RESIDENTIAL USE" from the label. This restriction is not required for this product.

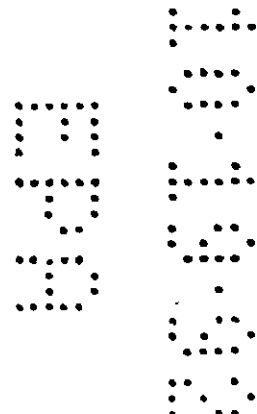

For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in clothing. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth. Do not apply to the hands of young children. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center.
