

This product can be applied with all types of hand or power sprayers. Read and carefully follow the instructions for the type of sprayer you use.

**MX** 3 1/2 ozs. per gallon (or 2 tablespoons per quart) of soft water.

**SPRAY** when insects first appear or damage is noticed. Thoroughly spray all infested areas to the point of runoff, hitting insects directly with insecticide spray where possible. Apply weekly as needed (repeat application after 2 or 3 days to control Aphids and Mealybugs). Can be used right to the day of harvest.
