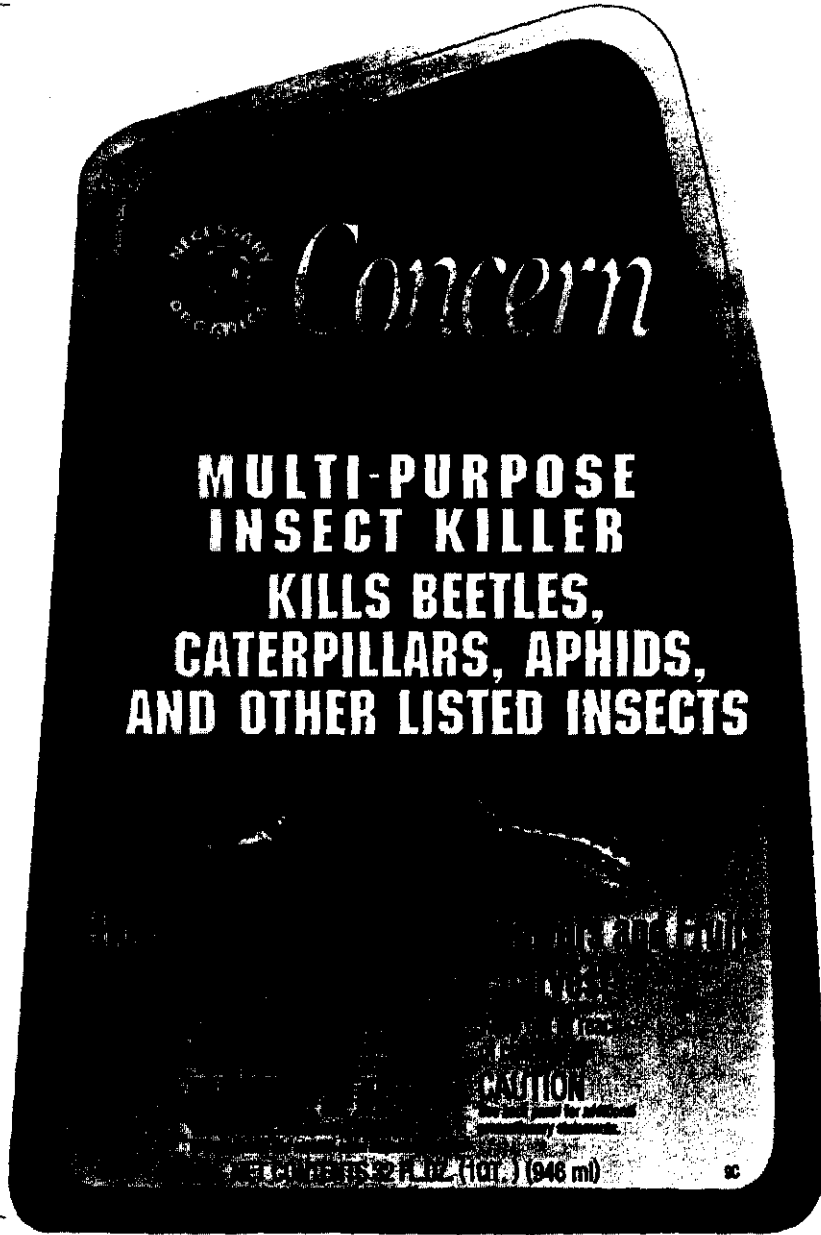

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BOTTLE WELL BEFORE USING

Spray when insects first appear. Hold container 12"-18" from plant and spray upper and lower leaf surfaces until slightly wet. Wet as many leaves with spray as possible. Do some to penetrate lower foliage. Treatment may be repeated weekly or as needed to control infestation. Avoid spraying plants in hot midday sun. When used outdoors, spray when air is still. Can be used right up to the day of harvest.

For Use On Vegetables & Fruits Including: Asparagus, beans, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, celery, collards, corn, cucumbers, cucumbers, eggplants, grapes, guava, kale, lettuce, peas, peppers, potatoes, radishes, spinach, squash, strawberries, tomatoes, turnips, etc.
