DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Directions: Shake well before using. Punch plastic seal. For use on carpets*, hold upside down and shake powder evenly across surface. Brush lightly with a broom to allow powder to penetrate carpet fibers. Wait 60 minutes, then vacuum. For severe problems or where ticks are known to be hiding, wait 2 - 3 hours before vacuuming. If powder adheres to a spot, brush it out and vacuum immediately. Apply to dry surfaces only. Do not allow powder to become wet. For use on upholstery*, remove all loose soil from surface. Sprinkle along creases, in corner, and back of sofa, wait 60 minutes, vacuum. Sprinkle along under side of furniture. Do not use on exposed fabric; this causes staining. Always be sure to vacuum cleaner. Strip seats from car and lay out on newspaper and dry in sun.

*Do not use on wet or soiled upholstery before cleaning. If upholstery is soiled or wet, do not use.
