PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. May cause eye irritation. Avoid eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control cockroaches, ants and silverfish, apply liberally, scattering under and behind refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs; into openings around drains, sewers, manholes, water pipes and electrical conduits; in cracks and crevices along baseboards and in corners of cabinets, cupboards and closets. Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dresser and chests of drawers, then scatter liberally in drawer wells.

Reapply as necessary. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices or removed. Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of feed and food-stuffs.

Directions for Applying in New Construction to Control Cockroaches - When treating large areas, such as wall voids, soffit and subcabinet voids in new and existing construction, dust liberally using dusting application equipment.

Directions for Applying as Mop Solution to Control Cockroaches - add 1 cup of powder to each gallon of rinse water. Apply to floor areas only. Make only enough for each application.

Direction for applying in Sewers to Control Cockroaches Apply 1 lb. of product in sewer using dusting application equipment.

This product may be used in homes, restaurants, and other food and feed handling establishments, markets, schools, warehouses, factories, offices, hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, garages, grocery stores, apartment buildings, new construction, industrial plants, theatres, ship, boats, trains, trucks, yachts, camps, mobile homes, buses, zoos, kennels, military bases, libraries, utilities and sewers.

CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT

FOOD AND FEED HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS - Places other than private residences in which exposed food or feed is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREA-APPLICATION, LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY

Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems such as mills, dairies, bakeries, restaurants or anywhere food or feed is stored, processed, prepared or served. Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation) also would be considered a food area.

Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment capable of applying insecticide directly into cracks and crevices, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housing and electrical switch boxes where cockroaches hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed food and feed processing, preparation and serving surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or feed processing surfaces.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AND FEED AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS, OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT, ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of construction into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

NON-FOOD AREAS - Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling.)

Apply to baseboard area, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and place in trash collection.
