This DISINFECTANT is effective against a wide variety of gram-positive and gram-negative bacteria. This DISINFECTANT is also a residual bacteriostat on environmental hard surfaces, inhibiting the growth of odor producing bacteria in areas of high moisture and on moist surfaces when used regularly and as directed.

This DISINFECTANT is also an excellent deodorant. Use it to control odors, especially those that are microbial in nature.

This DISINFECTANT mixes readily with water and makes a clear, stable solution. In use dilution, it is non-corrosive and non-staining to porcelain, enameled surfaces, glass, tile, plastic and most common metals.

CAUTION:

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid getting in eyes or on skin. In case of contact, wash thoroughly with water. If irritation persists, get medical attention. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuff. Avoid breathing spray mist.

DIRECTIONS:

Use in public rooms, homes, restaurants, barber and beauty shops and pet animal quarters for disinfecting floors, walls, tables, countertops and other porcelain, enamel, tile, plastic or vinyl surfaces or furnishings.

FOR DISINFECTION:

1. Flush away surface soils with water where possible.
2. Clean with a solution of 4 ounces of DISINFECTANT per gallon of water.
3. Rinse with clear water.
4. Apply disinfecting solution with a brush or scrubbing so as to thoroughly wet all surfaces. For non porous, easily cleaned areas, make up disinfecting solution of 4 ounces of DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. For porous areas (brick, painted wood, pitted or rough metal, unglazed terrazzo and tile), make a disinfecting solution of 8 ounces of DISINFECTANT per gallon of water.
5. Surfaces contacting food or feedstuff should be scrubbed roughly with detergent solution and rinsed with water prior to reuse.
