This is in regard to a submission by Ingredient Technology Corporation dated June 30, 1988 for the above-named product.

The information submitted by your supplier on the chemical identity of the fragrance satisfactorily fulfills our requirements in that regard. Therefore, the change in source of supply of the fragrance and dye as requested in your application dated April 24, 1987 is now acceptable.

The labeling submitted (April 27, 1987), in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you make the following revisions before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Place "Keep Out of Reach of Children" immediately above the signal word "CAUTION."
2. Move the statement "Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame" down in a separate paragraph. Precede this statement with the heading "Physical/Chemical Hazards."
3. Revise "First Aid" to read "Statement of Practical Treatment."
4. Revise the ingestion statement by deleting "of milk." The preferred ingestion statement is "If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water."

Submit the revised final printed labeling for inclusion in the product file.
