The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
  - a. Delete the entire Phenol Coefficients claim.
  - b. The statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" must be placed directly above the signal word "Caution."
  - c. Include a 10-minute contact time for the disinfection section.
  - d. Delete "milk."
  - e. Revise "First Aid" to "Statement of Practical Treatment."
  - f. In the ingredient statement the words "Active Ingredient" should be in the singular.
  - g. Delete the substatement "Contains Isopropanol and Methyl Salicylate" from below the ingredient statement.

If you wish, you may list all inert ingredients, pursuant in this formulation. You may not list some and not list the others.


2. submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
