GENERAL CLASSIFICATION: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

KILLS: Houseflies, mosquitoes, gnats, weeds, roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders, centipedes, ants, deer flies, horse flies.

DOUBLE ACTION INSECT KILLER—This is a dual purpose formulation that can be used as a contact spray against flying and crawling insects and as a residual insecticide providing up to 3 to 4 weeks of control of roaches.

Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS.

Indoors: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS

Outdoors: Reduce mosquitoes, gnats, (mosquitos), houseflies, biting flies and flying moths (moths) by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic foot of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

ROACHES, EARWIGS, GRAINMITES, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS AND CENTIPEDES:

Contact spray: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, metal areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Residual spray: Spray baseboards, cracks and crevices, around door and window frames and other hiding places such as closets, in back of and under appliances, sinks and cupboards in the kitchen and bathroom. In basements, spray hiding places in cracks, lower walls and dark places. Spray at the rate of 3 to 4 seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 14 inches from the surface. Repeat as necessary.

WASPS: Applications should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Apply to ant trails and around door sills, window frames and other places where ants may enter.

Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve directed. To avoid possible staining of fabrics or surfaces, do not spray

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS and FLYING MOTHS (millers): windows and spray room at the rate of 1 second per 100 cubic feet parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which are bright. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep area closed for 10 to 15 minutes. Repeat treatment as necessary.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, SPIDERS, CUCH BUGS: Spray into hiding places such as uncleaned crevices, behind baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, killing insects where possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where necessary.

INDIAN MEAL MOTHS and ANGOUMOUS GRAIN BEETLES: Close area and spray into all parts of room especially around stored food products and darkened areas.

Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 100 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed following treatment. Repeat application weekly or as needed.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly on beetles, baseboards, floors, etc. Repeat treatment as necessary.

CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOCHED GRAIN BEETLES, GRASS RICE WEEVILS, RED FLOUR BEETLES, GRAIN MITES: Spray into cleaning, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers and these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 cubic feet. Keep area closed 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application.

ICE: Spray on garments, bedding, mattresses, furniture, floors, carpet surfaces. First spray on inconspicuous area to test for possible staining. Inspect after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated.

Hold can upright with nozzle away from you. Press button and spray from a distance of 10 inches. Spray each square foot for 3 seconds, direct on infested surfaces until moist.

For bedding: Make sure spray is directed into corners of fitted sheets as well as inside and outside of pillow cases. In the case of garments and headgear, should be given to seams, hems, cuffs, collars, and creases. After wash, all garments must be either laundered in hot water or dry cleaned as recommended. For mattresses, furniture and carpeting. Direct spray into oil folds, crevices of infested areas until moist. Allow all treated surfaces to dry before use.

BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, molding and frames. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS: Spray sleeping quarters, bedding, floor and floor covering with insecticide. Repeat as necessary. Use only a recommended pet spray on pets.
