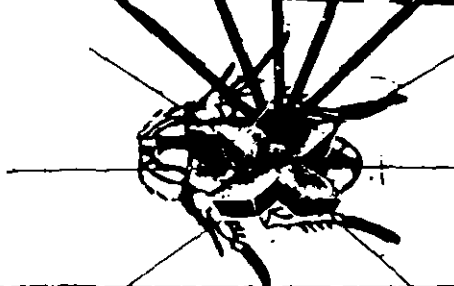

DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For use in households, restaurants, theaters, office buildings, aircraft, hotels, kennels, hospitals, schools; indoors and outdoors. To kill cockroaches, ants, crickets, spiders and other crawling pests attach extension tube and spray along baseboards, cracks and crevices, door trim and under cabinets and furniture.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS AND CRICKETS: Attach extension tube to spray actuator, spray floors along baseboards, directly into cracks, crevices and places suspected of harboring cockroaches. Contact as many insects as possible with spray.

TO KILL FLYING PESTS: Spray short bursts (10 seconds per 1000 cubic feet) into closed room. Keep room closed for 30 minutes. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

TO KILL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters and general floor areas without using extension tube.

- c. Change "3-phenoxybenzyl d-cis and trans* 2,2 dimethyl-2-(2-methylpropenyl) cyclopropanecarboxylate" to "3-phenoxybenzyl-(1RS, 2RS; 1S, 2SR) - 2, 2 -dimethyl-2-(2-methylprop-1-enyl) cyclopropanecarboxylate" and delete "*cis/trans isomer ratio: max. 25% (+ or -) cis/min. 75% (+ or -) trans."
- d. Bring your type size into compliance with 40 CFR Part 156.10, previously 40 CFR 162.10.
- e. Place a space between the statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling." and the rest of the directions for use section.
- f. Replace the Precautionary Statements section with the following.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

CAUTION

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. In hospital, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation. Avoid consumption of food and foodstuffs. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. Do not apply skin. Food processing is underway. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.
- If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air.

- If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
