

- d. Please provide detailed analytical methods. You may reference the method by citing the EPA Accession Number or by citing published literature or manuals.
- e. Precede the active ingredient with Diazinon followed by the chemical name in square brackets. Uppercase Diethyl.
- f. Change "May be fatal if swallowed" to "Harmful if swallowed."
- g. You may delete the Environmental Precautions paragraph since this is an indoor use only product.
- h. Delete "Resistant and Nonresistant Cockroaches." You may retain that statement provided you list the nature of resistance, e.g., dichlorvos-resistant cockroaches. This must be supported with appropriate data. Otherwise, use the term "cockroaches (waterbugs)" only.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas immediately with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Rinse eyes for at least 15 minutes with water and call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Product contains an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal, and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals

APPLICATIONS WITHIN FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

Limited to Crack and Crevice Treatment Only - Apply a small amount of material directly into cracks and crevices such as expansion joints between different elements of construction or between equipment bases and the floor, wall voids, junction boxes or switch boxes, conduits or hollow equipment legs where cockroaches, ants, spiders, and silverfish hide. Aids in the control of pantry pests (exposed stages of sawtoothed grain beetle, flour beetle, rice weevil, cigarette beetle, drugstore beetle, and Indian meal moth) which come in contact with treated surfaces. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Applications of this product in the food areas of food handling establishments, other than a crack and crevice treatment, are not permitted.

HOUSEHOLD INSECTS

RESISTANT AND NONRESISTANT COCKROACHES (WATERBUGS)

Dust thoroughly all areas where roaches crawl and hide, such as around water pipes, in cracks and crevices, under and behind cabinets, refrigerators, and sinks.

ANTS AND SILVERFISH

Dust thoroughly areas around waterpipes, in cracks under and behind cabinets, refrigerators, and sinks, around doors, windows, and bookcases.

CARPET BEETLES

Dust along baseboards, under carpeting, rugs, furniture, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected.

SPIDERS AND SCORPIONS

Dust around windows, doors, and along baseboards. Make spot applications to surfaces over which these pests crawl, particularly in crawl spaces under houses or buildings.
