

FASCASOL-97 is an emulsifiable spray oil designed for use against Spider Mites, Whiteflies, and certain Scale Insects attacking Citrus, Ornamentals, Avocado, Mango and Poinsettia. It should be diluted in water for use as directed below.

DIRECTIONS

Caution: If these directions may cause serious plant damage, consult your unsatisfactory control or other sources of information.

CITRUS — Against spider Mites and Whiteflies use 3 to 4 oz. per 10 gallons of spray (5 to 5 Pts. per 100 gallons). Apply for thorough coverage of top and bottom sides of leaves. Against Purple Scale, Florida Red Scale, Citrus, and Avocado Scale, Glover Scale use 5 gallons per 100 gallons tank (1 gallon 100 gallons). Apply for thorough coverage of all leaves, twigs, and fruit. Use with caution within the limits of the cautions given below.

ORNAMENTAL PLANTS — (Azaleas, Camellias, Gartnias, Holly, English, American, Citrus, Evergreens, Cherry, Pear, Almond, Apple, and other fruits, Spurge, Mints, Wisteria, and others) use 1 to 3 gallons of water. Apply when temperatures are above 60° F.

AVOCADO — Use 1 to 2 gallons of water. Apply when temperatures are above 60° F.

MANGO — Use 1 to 2 gallons of water. Apply when temperatures are above 60° F.

POMEGRANATE — Use 1 to 2 gallons of water. Apply when temperatures are above 60° F.

POINSETTIA — Use 1 to 2 gallons of water. Apply when temperatures are above 60° F.

NOTE: Do not apply to plants when temperatures are below 40° F. or above 90° F. This may cause damage to the product.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed.

Do not spray more than 3 gallons per 100 gallons of spray water. Do not spray on citrus trees during cold weather. Do not spray on citrus trees within 30 days before or after blossoming, and do not repeat oil sprays in less than 30 days of first applications, nor use more than two applications in the year. Do not spray trees or plants which are frost damaged from late frost, whatever such as lack of heat, too much moisture, cold or freeze damage, recent frost pruning or transplanting.

Avoid spraying citrus too late in the summer or the use of citrus oil may delay or retard natural coloring on the fruit. Oil sprays should not be applied to broad-leaved evergreens or palms when freezing or near freezing temperatures may be expected within 3 weeks after spray application. Do not use on maidenhair fern, "C. Caroliniana", Maples, cedar woolly plants unless specified. Avoid spraying trees, shrubs, when temperatures are excessively high or low, rain, sleet, or spray wind or motion while spraying. Do not spray on the following early in the day or fruit will drop off. Do not spray on citrus trees which have been recently sprayed with oil or lime sulfur. Do not spray on citrus trees which have been recently sprayed with oil or lime sulfur.
