

Crop

Beans, bean forage, beans-hay, corn-fresh (including field, sweet, pop, seed). corn fodder, corn forage, cucurbits and melons, peanuts, peanuts-hay, peas (with pods), potatoes, soybeans, sweet potatoes.

Pest

Adult Diabroticine Beetles (Diabrotica and Acalymma species).

Rate

Broadcast rate of 0.5 pounds (8 ounces) to 0.75 pounds (12 ounces) per acre per application.
Maximum of 3.75 pounds per crop growing season.

Application

Broadcast or band application. Dilute with water for a minimum of one gallon finished spray per acre by aerial application and a minimum of five gallons finished spray per acre by ground application.

Thoroughly mix solution and maintain adequate agitation. Use 20 mesh screens or coarser.

Timing

Apply at beetle emergence in the spring before egg laying begins, or when beetle population levels reach the economic threshold and injury levels for the crop. Repeat applications if scouting the crop indicates further control measures need to be taken. Consult your local Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service crop consultant for further information regarding Diabroticine beetle control on crops in your area.
