- 4. Submit your corrected Confidential Statement of Formula, EPA Form 8570-4 reflecting any changes resulting from the method validation being conducted by the EPA lab within 30 days of our notification of such needed changes.
- 5. Provide the outstanding generic data identified on the attachments A and B to this Notice within the established timeframes as noted on these attachments.
- 6. Submit two copies of the corrected final printed label before you release the product for shipment.
