CHERRIES: Brown Rot - Apply 5 to 7 lbs. in 100 gallons of spray at white bud stage.

CITRUS:

Brown Rot, Septoria - Apply 2 lbs. in 100 gallons of spray. Spray lower branches 1/2 to 3 feet from ground in late fall at time of first rains and again later as needed in extra wet years.

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#### PEACHES, NECTARINES:

Brown Rot, Peach Blight, Leaf Curl - Apply 5 to 7 lbs. per 100 gallons of spray. With dormant oil spray, apply 5 1/2 lbs. per 100 gallons of spray. May be applied up to full pink stage.

#### WALNUTS:

Walnut Blight - Apply 4 to 6 lbs. per 100 gallons of spray. Two sprays are needed, one when 1% of flowers are showing and second when 10% of flowers are showing. A third application may be used post bloom in severe areas.

#### ZINC AND COPPER DEFICIENCY SPRAY

Dormant Spray: Use 4 to 6 lbs. in 100 gallons of spray added to dormant oil emulsion spray or 5 to 6 lbs. as water spray.

Foliage Spray: Use 3 to 4 lbs. per 100 gallons as a water spray over new foliage. For foliage oil emulsion sprays, use 1 lb. per 100 gallons of spray.
