Dear Ms Robey:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided the following changes are made:

- 1. In the Spanish language warning, change "en detaile" to "en detaile"
- 2. At the bottom of the FIRST AID block, add the following: "Note to physician: probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."
- 3. In the section "Personal Protective Equipment", change "Chemical-resistant gloves" to "Chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material" in the subsections for Applicators and for Mixers and Loaders.
- 4. In the Agricultural Use Requirements box, change "Chemical-resistant gloves" to "Chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material"
- 5. The "Conditions of Sale and Warranty" statements must make it clear that the disclaimer statement concerning consequential, special and indirect damages is the registrant's and does not come from EPA. This can be done by using statements such as "To the fullest extent permitted by law, the manufacturer shall not be liable...." or "It is the manufacturer's intention that...."

One copy of the label stamped "Accepted with comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit one copy of the final printed label that incorporates the required changes before the product is released for shipment.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. RECOMMENDATIONS

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POTATO SEED PIECE TREATMENT:

Damp-off, seed rot fungi, brown eye disease, verticillium wilt - Apply at the rate of 11 1/4 ounces per bushel cut seed pieces (18 ounces or 1 1/8 pounds to 100 pounds of cut seed pieces). Apply in convenient container or by duster attachment over belt. Coat each seed piece evenly with a light film of dust. Treat pieces within 6 hours after cutting. If planting is delayed, store treated seed pieces in open crates for two days before bagging. Do not use excess seed pieces for food or feed purposes.

SOIL AND GREENHOUSE BENCH TREATMENT:

For damp-off and root rot diseases of seedlings and transplants of roses, other shrubs, flowers and lawn seedbeds. Apply 2 1/4 pounds per 1,000 square feet (98 pounds per acre). Work into upper 3 or 4 inches of soil before planting.

Only the applicator is permitted to be in the greenhouse during application of Captan. Open vents to greenhouse during application and for at least 1 hour after application.

ORNAMENTALS:

ROSES - (black spot), CARNATION - (rust, leaf spot), CHRYSANTHEMUM - (flower blight) - Apply with a dust applicator to provide a light, uniform coating to leaf surfaces prior to or at first sign of disease. Repeat applications at 7 to 10 day intervals. Shorten interval during periods of frequent rain and heavy dews.
