#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READY TO USE - No dilution necessary.

### APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Pour along back line and down face. Apply ½ fl. oz. per 100 lbs. body weight of animal, up to a maximum of 5 fl. oz. for any one animal to control Lice, Horn Flies and Face Flies. Aids in control of Horse Flies, Stable Flies, Mosquitoes, Black Flies and Ticks on lactating and non-lactating dairy cattle, beef cattle, calves and sheep.

For Keds on sheep, pour along back line over neck, shoulders and rump. Apply 1/4 fl. oz. per 50 lbs body weight of animal, up to a

maximum cf 3 fl. oz. for any one animal.

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Repeat treatment as needed, but not more than once every 2 weeks. For optimum lice control, a double treatment at 14 day intervals is recommended.

NOTE: This product is not effective for grub control on cattle.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Keep container sealed when not in use. Do not store near food or feed. Pesticide wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

DISPOSAL: Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. Container One Gallon and Under: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly, wrap in several layers of newspaper and place in trash.
