Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply to Dairy Cattle (lactating and non-lactating) and, Beef Cattle.

APPLICATION: For up to 6 weeks' control of susceptible horn flies, apply over shoulders and down midline of back.

For control of lice and aid in control of face flies, stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, house flies, mosquitoes, and black flies, apply from poll down neck, over shoulders.

DOSE: 1/8 fl. oz. (3.75 ml) per 250 lbs. body wt. to maximum of 1/2 fl. oz. (15 ml) per animal. (1 ml = 1 cc). Repeat treatment as needed, but not more often than once every 2 weeks. For optimum lice control, two treatments at a 14 day interval are recommended.

DO NOT USE ON HORSES.

SPECIAL NOTE: This product is non-systemic and will not control grubs.

This is a highly concentrated formulation. Use only with accurate measuring container or applicator.

Permethrin 10% Pour On should be used in an integrated pest management system which may involve repeat treatments and the use of other pest control practices.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, or fuller's earth.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
