

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Applicators and other handlers must wear:

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AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. COTTON SEED TREATMENT

A ready-to-use hopper box seed dressing to enhance seed germination rates and promote greater early season root development. For use; solely as an at planting treatment. Use of seed treated with PGR-

IV ST at the recommended rates precludes the need for in furrow application of PGR-IV at planting time. Do not allow treated seed to be used for food or feed.

Apply PGR-IV ST directly to the seed in the hopper box using 3 to 6 ounces of PGR-IV ST per 50 pounds of seed.

Partially fill hopper box with premeasured amount of seed. Apply appropriate amount of PGR-IV ST on the surface of the seed. Mix with a stick or paddle until all seeds are coated. Repeat procedure until hopper box is filled
