Dear Mr. Washburm:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Add "prepared" under FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENT, "......where food is held, processed, prepared or served."
- 2. Correct the typo's "Cramba" with "Crambe", "Braccica" with "Brassica", and "Schrubs" with "Shrabs".
- 3. Delete "In no case shall Micro Flo or seller be liable for consequential, special, or indirect damages resulting from the use or handling of this product." from the Warranty Statement. This statement is overly broad and implies buyer has no legal right to recover damages from manufacturer and is unacceptable under statutory and regulatory standards. We recommend revising it to read "To the fullest extent permitted by law Micro Flo or seller shall not be liable for any etc" or "It is Micro Flo or seller intention that in no case shall Micro Flo or seller be liable etc."
