LABELING: (Statements are based on review of referenced acute toxicity data)

1. The signal word is "DANGER"
2. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust or spray mists. Irritating to nose and throat. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

3. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician or poison control center immediately.

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably, mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

GENERAL INFORMATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

EZ Clor® Refill Tabs help prevent growth of algae and bacteria in swimming pools. Place tablets in a floating or stationary feeding device or in a summer—ONLY IF PLUMBING IS NON-METALLIC.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Before using EZ Clor Refill Tabs for the first time, pool water should be stabilized with EZ Clor Chlor Shock. Follow directions on the label for that product. EZ Clor Tabs increase the effective life of chlorine by reducing loss caused by the sun's rays. Add the EZ Clor Tabs slowly to the pool's summer, or shanty in a bucket of hot water and add to the deep end of the pool. Do not push down the filter for two days following other method of application.
2. Then treat the pool with a shock dose of chlorinating compound, using EZ Clor Shock Out. Follow directions on the label for that product. After several hours, check the chlorine residual to determine if at least 1.0 to 1.5 ppm has been obtained. If the chlorine residual is less than 1.0 to 1.5 ppm, repeat the shock dose until at least 1.0 to 1.5 ppm has been obtained.
3. Place 4-6 tablets in dispenser being used to provide daily chlorination per 10,000 gallons. Add additional tablets if needed to maintain a chlorine residual at 1.0 to 1.5 ppm as determined by a suitable test kit. Once a shock dose (see No. 2 above) whenever algae first becomes visible.
4. Adjust and maintain proper pH in the range of 7.2-7.6, using pH Up or pH Down, as indicated by the EZ Clor Test Kit.

Reentry. Reentry into treated swimming pool is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm of chlorine.
