Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment:

1. Refer to the enclosed Attachment A for the necessary revisions to the Precautionary Statements for the subject product.
2. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read: "This pesticide is toxic to fish and other aquatic organism. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this

3. Delete the heading "General Information" and place the Misuse Statement under the "Directions For Use" heading.

Submit one copy of the final printed labeling before releasing the product in channels of trade with the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Attachment A - Batch 26 Products

Labeling:

1. The signal word is "Danger".

2. The Precautionary Statements should read:

"Corrosive: Cause irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if inhaled. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe dust, vapor or spray mist. Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse".

3. The Statements of Practical Treatment should read:

"If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention".

"If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention".

"If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists".

"If swallowed: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Get medical attention".

GENERAL INFORMATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.
E-Z CLOR Quick Dissolve helps prevent growth of algae and bacteria in swimming pools.
E-Z CLOR Quick Dissolve is a plastic bucket of water, then add to deep end of pool at discretion.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Before using E-Z CLOR Quick Dissolve for the first time, pool water should be stabilized. Follow directions on the label for that product. Close Save in chlorine by reducing loss caused by the sun's rays. Add the CLOR Save slowly to in a bucket of hot water and add to the deep end of the pool. Do not backwash using either method of application.
2. Then treat the pool with a shock dose of chlorinating compound, using E-Z CLOR on the label for that product. After several hours, check the chlorine residual to 2.0 ppm has been obtained. If the chlorine residual is less than 1.0 to 2.0 ppm at least that level has been obtained.
3. The pool should be treated with 2 oz. Quick Dissolve per 10,000 gallons every chlorine residual of 1.0 to 2.0 ppm. Give a shock dose (see no. 2 above) whenever b/c. (1 cup = 0.01 oz.)
4. Adjust and maintain proper pH in the range of 7.2-7.6 using pH Up or pH Down. Test kit.

Reentry. Reentry into treated swimming pool/spa is prohibited of chlorine.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
