1. By January 31, 2011, provide to the Agency acceptable data packages for Guideline Studies as follows: OPPTS 830.6317 (Storage Stability) and 830.6320 (Corrosion Characteristics).

2. Make the following changes to the label:

a. Based on the Agency’s product chemistry review (copy attached), revise the ingredient statement to match the nominal concentration on the latest approved CSF of 99.62% as follows:

“ACTIVE INGREDIENT:
Benzyl Benzoate.....99.62%
OTHER (INERT) INGREDIENTS:.....0.38%
TOTAL:.....100.00%”

b. Based on the Agency’s acute toxicity review (copy attached), revise the signal word from “Warning!” to “Caution”.

Also, revise the HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS statement to read as follows:

“HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:
Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, or clothing. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing dust.”*

*The designation of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for manufacturing use products does not fall under the jurisdiction of EPA, therefore PPE has not been specified for this product.

However, instead of listing recommended PPE in the HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS statement, it is permissible to add a “USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS” statement as follows:

“USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS:
User should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

Also, revise “STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT” to read “FIRST AID”.

Also, revise the order of FIRST AID statements to read as follows:

“FIRST AID:
IF SWALLOWED: . . .
IF IN EYES: . . .
IF INHALED: . . .

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact (336) 292-1781 for emergency medical treatment information.”.

The additional statements in the NOTE TO PHYSICIAN and NOTICE statement on plasticizing effects are acceptable.

c. Revise the "CONTAINER DISPOSAL portion of the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL statement as follows:

"CONTAINER HANDLING: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into formulation equipment. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into formulation equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities."

Also, add the statement "keep away from strong oxidizers" somewhere to the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL statement

Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. If you have any questions, you may contact Richard J.
