AQUAPEL® Pump Spray 27413 is a convenient, easy to use pump spray that allows quick and thorough application to skin, hair, and clothing for maximum protection.

Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears.

Do not apply to children's hands. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect a reaction to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin, and call your local Poison Control Center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent product with you.

Hold container upright about 4 - 6 inches from skin or clothing. Do not spray in enclosed areas. If used on face, spray on hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face. Do not use as a space spray. Spray and spread evenly with your hand to moisten all exposed skin. Also, apply to clothing such as shirt, pants, hat, and socks. Frequent reapplication and saturation of clothing are unnecessary for effectiveness. For Chiggers and Ticks, apply to shirt and pant cuffs and socks.
