Do not spray in enclosed areas. Avoid breathing a spray product and do not use it near food. Spray and spread evenly with your hand to moisten all exposed skin. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness.
