Dear Ms. Sullivan,

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. “To distribute or sell” is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company’s website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product’s label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA’s Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6. 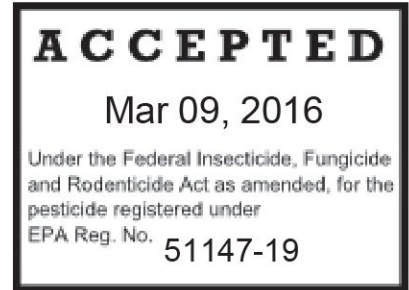

MORPEL® Pressurized Repellent Spray 2850 provides protection against Mosquitoes, Black Flies, Stable Flies, Sand Flies, Gnats, Chiggers, Fleas, and Ticks. Convenient, easy to use aerosol spray allows quick and thorough application to skin, hair, and clothing for maximum protection.

[STOP] Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label. Hold container upright about 4 to 6 inches from skin or clothing. Do not use as a face spray. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Avoid breathing a spray product and do not use it near food. Spray and spread evenly with your hand to moisten all exposed skin. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. If biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more. Do not apply near eyes and mouth, and apply sparingly around ears. When using sprays, do not spray directly into face, spray on hands first and then apply to face. Do not allow children to handle this product, and do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Instruct older children in the proper use of this product. Apply this product second if used in conjunction with a sunscreen product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water or bathe. This is particularly important when repellents are used repeatedly in a day or on consecutive days. Do not use under clothing. For Chiggers and Ticks, apply to shirt and pant cuffs or socks.
