regarding addition of fire ants to the label.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with
registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide
Act, as amended, is acceptable if you make the following changes on your
label:

1. Under Directions for Use, change the statement "This treatment will
not kill the colonies but will reduce the immediate population for up
to four hours." to read as follows: "This treatment will not kill
the colonies but will reduce the immediate population."
2. Change the "TO TREAT FIRE ANT MOUNDS" portion of the Directions for
Use to read as follows:

TO TREAT FIRE ANT MOUNDS: May be injected into mounds. Use rate is
4 lbs/gallon or 1 lb/25 gallons of water. Insert injection pipe as
far as it will go into the mound, then inject spray at 100 PSI.
Continue to inject spray until the product surfaces and ponds slightly.
Remove injection pipe from the mound. Moisten a 6 to 8 foot circular
area around the mound.
3. The dry powder use directions must be more specific with regards to
rate, injection pressure and treatment around the mound. Please
provide efficacy data with regard to the dry powder injection method
if available.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply lightly in all areas where insects and pest hide. Repeat as necessary. For ROACHES and SILVERFISH, apply in cracks and crevices around windows, baseboards, door frames, appliances, behind furniture, pictures, around pipes, sink, and food storage areas. For ANTS thoroughly apply around doors and windows. For BEDBUGS apply to baseboards, moldings, and cracks, thoroughly. Apply to side of mattress and bedstead. For FLEAS apply where pets sleep. For HOUSE-FLIES apply lightly on window sills and frames.

FIRE ANTS: Kills and temporarily reduces annoyance of these insects. To reduce annoyance from ants and keep them from entering homes, spray patios, barbecue areas, driveways, entryways, door sills, window sills, other entrance areas, foundations of buildings, ant trails, around pools and areas where ants are noticed. Spray until the area is wet contacting as many insects as possible. This treatment will not kill the colonies but will reduce the immediate population for up to four hours. Repeat as necessary.

TO TREAT FIRE ANT MOUNDS: May be injected into mounds by mixing 4 lbs./gallons or 1 lb./25 gallons of water and inject at 100 PSI until product surfaces and ponds slightly. Dry powder may be injected by using air pressure.
