TO TREAT FIRE ANT MOUNDS: May be injected into mounds by mixing 4 lbs/gallon or 1 lb./25 gallons of water and inject at 100 PSI until product surfaces and ponds slightly. Dry powder may be injected by using air pressure. May be used on Coll Courses.
