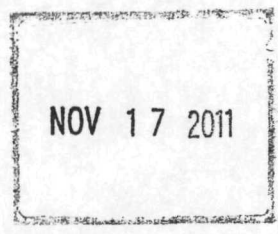

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the conditions listed below:

- Revise label as per PR Notice 2007-4

Conditions

Revise your Storage and Disposal Section to read exactly as follows as per PR Notice 83-3 and 2007-4:

“Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in cool dry place inaccessible to children.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes may be hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Handling: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent.) Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.”

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For up to 30 gallons of water, start treatment by dropping 1 tablet into humidifier reservoir, evaporative cooler reservoir, or drain pan of air conditioner. Apply 1 additional tablet every 3 months or whenever odors occur. Treatment may be more effective if drain pan or reservoir is emptied and cleaned before each tablet application.
