"To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and it's implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

When used according to directions ACTABS™ DMSS for Ductless Mini Split Systems will inhibit the growth of the following organisms: *Thermoactinomyces vulgaris*, *Pseudomonas effusa*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Bacillus circulans*, *Bacillus licheniformis*, *Bacillus megaterium*, *Aerobacter aerogenes* and *Escherichia coli*. Safe to use with condensate pumps.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For up to 30 gallons of water, start treatment by dropping 1 tablet into humidifier reservoir, evaporative cooler reservoir, or drain pan of air conditioner. Apply 1 additional tablet every 3 months or whenever odors occur. Treatment may be more effective if drain pan or reservoir is emptied and cleaned before each tablet application.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

DANGER. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear chemical goggles, protective clothing, and rubber gloves. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

FIRST AID
